Things didn't slow down in 2013, in fact, we managed to achieve so much more! With our mission goals firmly in place, we managed to provide so much more aid than wheelchairs alone.



In the past year we were able to do the following:

- ▶ Recycled 30 tones of equipment
- ▶ Delivered first 200 wheelchairs
- ▶ Created new partnerships with Child Aid and local authorities in MD
- ▶ 30 beds and eCG machines donated to Riscani Cardiology unit
- ▶ School furniture donated to Mihaileni and Riscani schools
- ▶ 78 wheelchairs donated to children and adults from north of Moldova during the Balti event
- ▶ 14 wheelchairs donated to Second world war veterans
- ▶ 30 beds, bedside lockers, Incubators donated to Mother and Child Hospital Chisinau
- ▶ 20 Baby scales donated to villages doctors
- ▶ Signed the 49 years lease for the building from Riscani local authorities

“ Here are some stories from some of those we helped;

Natalia and her husband were carrying her brother, a 34 years old in a sack on their back, coming to receive their first wheelchair. Ion was disabled from birth, but had never had a wheelchair.

With every wheelchair donated we give the chance to breathe fresh air, and be able as Alexandru pointed out - to see the trees and life outside of four walls.

A parent said: “We brought our child to hospital last night, and look how the wire is sticking through the mattress, adding pain to so much pain”

Rodica needed a wheelchair for her daughter and John was so touched by this little girl. He asked the prison headmaster – who at the time was refurbishing every wheelchair for us – to colour one in pink. They couldn't but managed to get one in nice bright yellow, The mother, who was carrying her daughter until we provided the wheelchair, was so happy to receive it. ”
